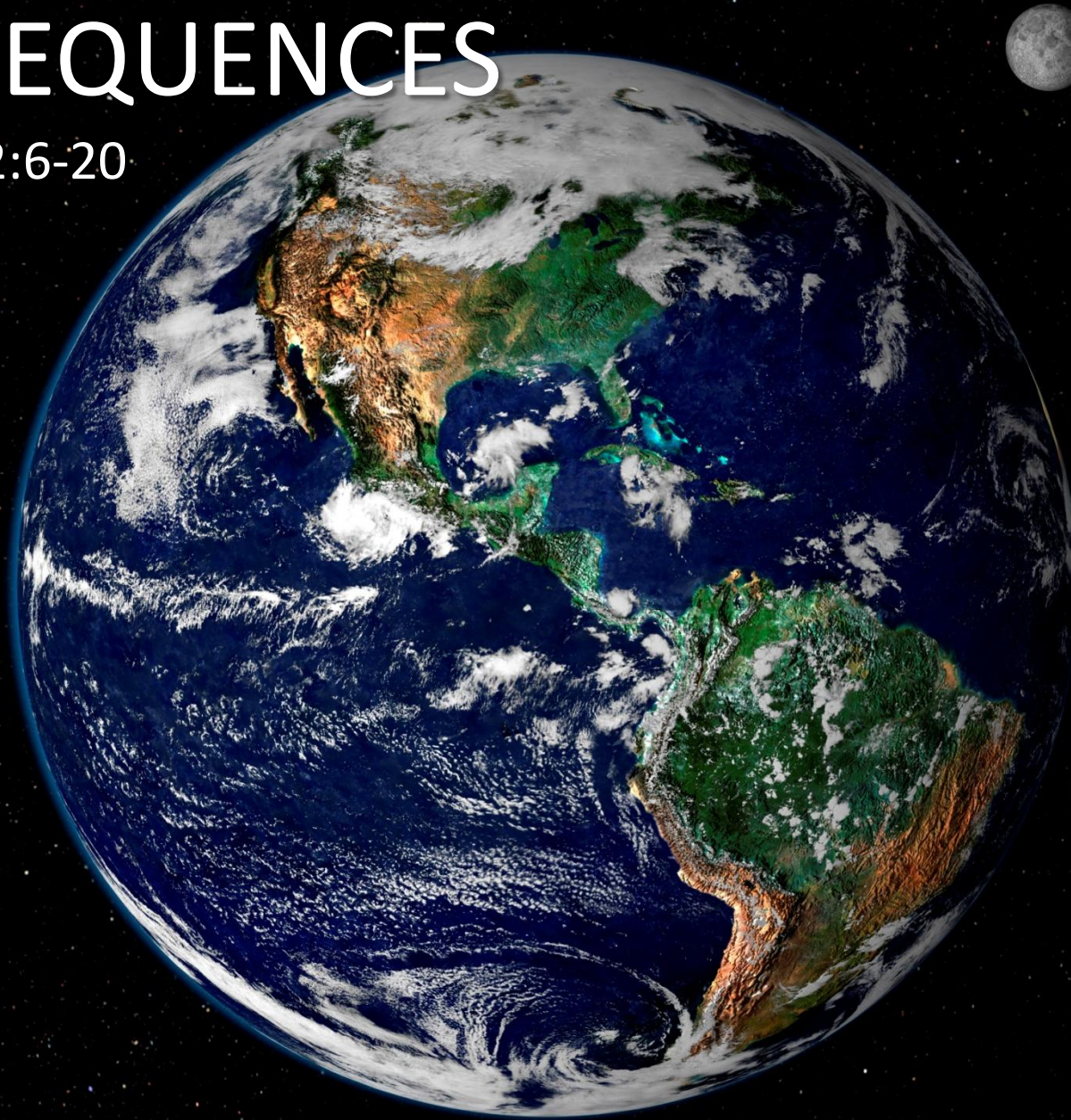


# CONSEQUENCES

5 woes

- \* Magnifies the sin nature of man
- \* Warning of consequences
- \* Focus is not on sin but God's faithfulness
- \* Taunting in form of poetry –  
5 stanzas/3verses each
