



### AN UPDATE FROM THE BARRETTS

Stephen and Cindi Barrett serve with Athletes in Action International, a division of Cru.

"Greetings from Missouri! Kareem (named changed for security) is a wrestler from Tajikistan. Although he is Muslim and has not come to faith in Christ, I (Stephen) have shared with him every chance I get. He asked me to be his coach in the Tajik national wrestling tournament in February. The date for the tournament was set about two weeks ahead of time (nothing like planning!), and I found out one week before the tournament! Cindi worked her connections and purchased a ticket for me to fly three days later. It's hard to put into words all the ways I saw the Lord's hand guiding me during this trip. One of my favorite families just happens to live in Tajikistan, had a guest room, and were happy to host me. In addition to coaching Kareem in the tournament (where he took 3rd place), I was able to share my testimony with a local Jujitsu club. We also drove up over the mountains to Kareem's hometown where we spoke to 150 young wrestlers and delivered Operation Christmas Child shoe boxes. We played with the kids, shared the Gospel and our testimonies, and gave out gifts. There is no church in this town of 50,000. Please pray that a church would be started there!"
