

- 1. Jesus being fully God is the most distinctively Christian doctrine of all.
- 2. Jesus being fully God is the essential difference between orthodox, traditional, biblical, apostolic, historic, creedal Christianity and revisionist, modernist, liberal teaching.
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- 4. If Jesus is in fact fully God, then the incarnation (or the coming of Jesus as fully man in the flesh) is the most important event in history.

- Modalism (God is one divine being Who operates in modes at any given time)
- Ebionism/possibly thought descended from Judaizers (Jesus was a man, and became God's Son by being adopted by Him)
- Docetism/possibly thought descended from Gnostics (Jesus and His historical and bodily existence was a mere semblance of reality)
- Arius (Jesus is a created being and of a different substance than God the Father)

- Apollinarius (Jesus' divine nature displaced His human mind and will, therefore Jesus was not fully human)
- Nestorius (Jesus has two separate natures and two wills, essentially making Him two persons sharing one body)
- Eutyches (Jesus was not truly human because any human nature was "absorbed" or swallowed up by His divine nature)
- Councils of Nicaea (325), Constantinople, Ephesus 1 & 2, culminating in Chalcedon (451)

- Honor, Glory, Worship, Prayer, Song, Faith, Fear,
   Service, Love
  - John 5:21-23 For as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whom He will. For the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father Who sent Him.

#### • Attributes of God

- All, Preexistent, Eternal, Uncreated, Unchanging, Loving, All-Powerful, All-Present, All-Knowing, Incomprehensible
  - John 12:45 And whoever sees Me sees Him Who sent Me.

#### Names of God

- Name above every name, God, Lord, Bridegroom/
  Husband, King of kings & Lord of lords, Savior, I Am,
  First & Last/Alpha & Omega/Beginning & End
  - Philippians 2:9-11 Therefore God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

#### · Deeds that God Does

- Creating and sustaining all things, Sovereignly ruling over the forces of nature, Illumination and revelation, Speaking with divine authority, Word of the Lord, Salvation, Showing mercy, Forgiveness of sins, Sending the Spirit & His gifts,
   Giving and being life, Raising the dead, Source of all spiritual blessings, Judging all people
  - Colossians 1:16-17 For by Him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities —all things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

- Seat of God's Throne
  - God's highest possible throne, Claiming to be equal to God, Ruling over all things, ruling forever
    - Psalm 110:1 The LORD [God the Father] says to my Lord [Jesus], "Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool."
